On behalf of the school, the Friends are administering the WMIS Education Budget, which was created to fund educational materials and services that benefit each child directly. As of mid-October, we have only received contributions by 43% of our students/families. At the same time teachers have already spent on average 30 EUR for each child for activities and materials. COMIC CLUB TINY COMICS



A few 4A students (Ryan T., Harry A., Leora C.G., Lucien T. and a few more) recently established their own comic club. Science @ WMIS

In primary school, learning natural sciences requires not only theoretical teaching but also practical and sensory experiences. Children are more likely to develop an interest in science if they come into close "contact" with the topics, i.e. if the topics are presented multi-sensory. Last year, the Friends secured financial support from the Bayer Foundation to make the topic of "senses" comprehensible to our youngest students hands-on. For three scientific teaching modules, we acquired teaching materials such as an experimental kit on sounds and noises, sensory tubes and boxes, as well as large eye and ear models. Theater@WMIS

Anna Watson is thrilled about Theatre InBetween's collaboration with WMIS: "This is a great group of children to work with, with so many different cultural backgrounds. The different languages and the school's motto Earth, Arts, Action is a mind blowing drive to get creative." Their Theatre Makes You Louder! elective (WUF) classes offer our 5- and 6-graders an introduction to the world of theater. For Anna, "Theatre is a place to play, try things out, and create art for art's sake." This boosts self-confidence and offers creative expression through imaginative play. In this safe space, the young WMIS actors can slip into different characters, situations and emotions. They get to take on a wide variety of perspectives and learn to express themselves in a variety of ways. "Theatre gives voice. Drama makes you strong. Theatre Makes You Louder!"

Library Upgrade

With our Run2Read action, we collected donations of more than €8000. About one-third of the funds will be used for a **complete** make-over and remodelling of the library (benches, stools, chairs, tables for working, carpets, book boxes, and librarian's counter). This is complemented by new bookshelves procured from the school's furniture budget. The remaining money (€5000) is spent on **new books**. The book selection is coordinated by Mr Stevens according to class & SPB needs as well as student preferences. Last but not least, a new software package is currently rolled out to manage the library catalogues and the loan & return process.
